# MCIC Educational Offerings - Spring 2020

## \*Basic Computerized Estimating – limited to one attendee per member company

6 Sessions—Tuesdays – February 25, March 3, 10, 17, 24, 31 Instructor: John Corallo, Binsky & Snyder

This course will focus on computer estimating for Mechanical Contracting, using software from <u>Viewpoint</u> (Formerly <u>Maxwell</u>). This course is limited to 12 people who are estimators or those who have completed the Blueprint Reading & Estimating Class.

### Advanced Commercial HVAC/R

6 Sessions—Wednesdays – February 26, March 4, 11, 18, 25 and April 1 Instructor: Frank Raimondi, United Cooling and Refrigeration

This course is advanced in nature, and the enrollment will be restricted to allow only those individuals who are journeymen technicians. In addition to concepts in the industry, there will be a troubleshooting section of the course, if requested by the students.

## \*Basic Computerized Scheduling — limited to one attendee per member company

5 Sessions—Thursdays – February 27, and March 5, 12, 19, 26 Instructor: Keith Brown, Brown Engineering

Successful project execution <u>requires</u> adequate planning and tracking. This allows you to minimize job site inefficiency, accurately predict workforce requirements, and provide documentation to allow you to get paid for changes and claims caused by others. This course will make you more aware of the time-related costs that impact all of your projects, and by using Microsoft Project 2013 scheduling software, how to accurately schedule your jobs. You will learn how to document and recover your real costs caused by delays, changes, etc., thereby improving the profitability of all your projects. This course is limited to 12 people.

### American Red Cross Standard

1 Session—Monday, May 4 from 4:00 to 10:00 pm AED. CPR and First Aid

Instructor: American Red Cross

This course, taught by a Red Cross instructor, will cover all aspects of First Aid, CPR & AED. Due to American Red Cross regulations, space in this class is limited.
