This course will make you more aware of the time-related costs that impact your projects and, using Microsoft Project 2013 scheduling software, how to accurately schedule your jobs. In addition, you will learn how to document and recover your real costs caused by delays, changes, etc., thereby improving your projects' profitability. This course is limited to 12 people.
